School history and community

APDE El Roble School is a private, nonprofit, bilingual, boys only, day school located in Guatemala City. Founded in 1970 the school has grown to over 700 students and graduated its first senior class in 1977. Our students are people of integrity who:

- · Have received a well-rounded academic experience
- Have formed a Catholic identity and values
- Are ready to go out and serve their families, communities and society

El Roble is proud of its ability to provide an exceptionally rigorous academic program that is also inclusive to students with special learning needs.

Student enrollment and demographics

Students are almost exclusively Guatemalan nationals, with some guest students from other Latin American countries. The school maintains three classes per grade, 20-25 students per class.

School Calendar

El Roble's school year begins in January and ends in mid-October.

It consists of 180 school days organized into four quarters and it observes local Guatemalan holidays and schedules recesses in Easter, mid-June, and early autumn. The school day is divided into six 60-minute periods and one 50-minute study hall period.



Testing Restrictions on international students:

In recent years our students have had less access to SAT/SAT Subject and ACT tests because of fewer test dates abroad, fewer sites offering the test, technology difficulties and higher fees. We ask that all higher education institutions take this into account when evaluating our students' applications.



Graduation requirements and curriculum

- Students follow a common core, university preparatory bilingual curriculum as mandated by the Guatemalan Ministry of Education.
- 9th & 10th Grades students take an average of 13 courses per year.
- 11th & 12th Grades students complete the two-year International- Baccalaureate Programme in addition to local requirements.
- Each full-year academic course passed earns 1 credit. IB courses in grades 11th & 12th are weighted with an additional 0.5 credit.
- Spanish is the main language of instruction, 80% of the academic courses are taught in Spanish.
